Morning Workshops:**First Aid - Appointed Persons**

This first aid course will cover specific sporting injuries related to the sport of the coaches on the course. The qualification is valid for 3 years and is a minimum standard for deployment for Wiltshire & Swindon coaches.

Coaching the Whole Child: Positive Development through Sport (SCUK)

This workshop is an exciting chance for coaches to consider the emphasis of their coaching and enhance the experience of young participants in the process. The workshop introduces the 5Cs of coaching children: Competence, Confidence, Connection, Character and Caring & Creativity.

An Introduction to the FUNDamentals of Movement (MS2) (SCUK)

A practical workshop that explores the concepts of Agility, Balance and Coordination. It will help coaches observe, analyse and coach good movement patterns within their sessions. This workshop is a minimum standard for deployment for Wiltshire & Swindon coaches.

Afternoon Workshops:**Safeguarding & Child Protection (SCUK)**

This workshop focuses on the essential good practices to protect the child and the coach. This is a prerequisite for any NGB coaching qualification and a minimum standard for deployment for Wiltshire & Swindon coaches.

Challenging Behaviour

A practical session to explore appropriate solutions to deal with unwanted challenging behaviour, including the right environment, tips for coaching and appropriate verbal and body language.

Recognising Talent

So many children, so many differing abilities, so many ways of developing them! This practical workshop will look at how to spot talent early on, the skills to look out for and the right tools in order to do this.

Multi-Skill Clubs in Practice (MS3) (SCUK)

This workshop is a follow-on from MS2 and will help coaches integrate the ABC's into multi-skill club sessions. You will be able to develop and share good practice with other coaches.
