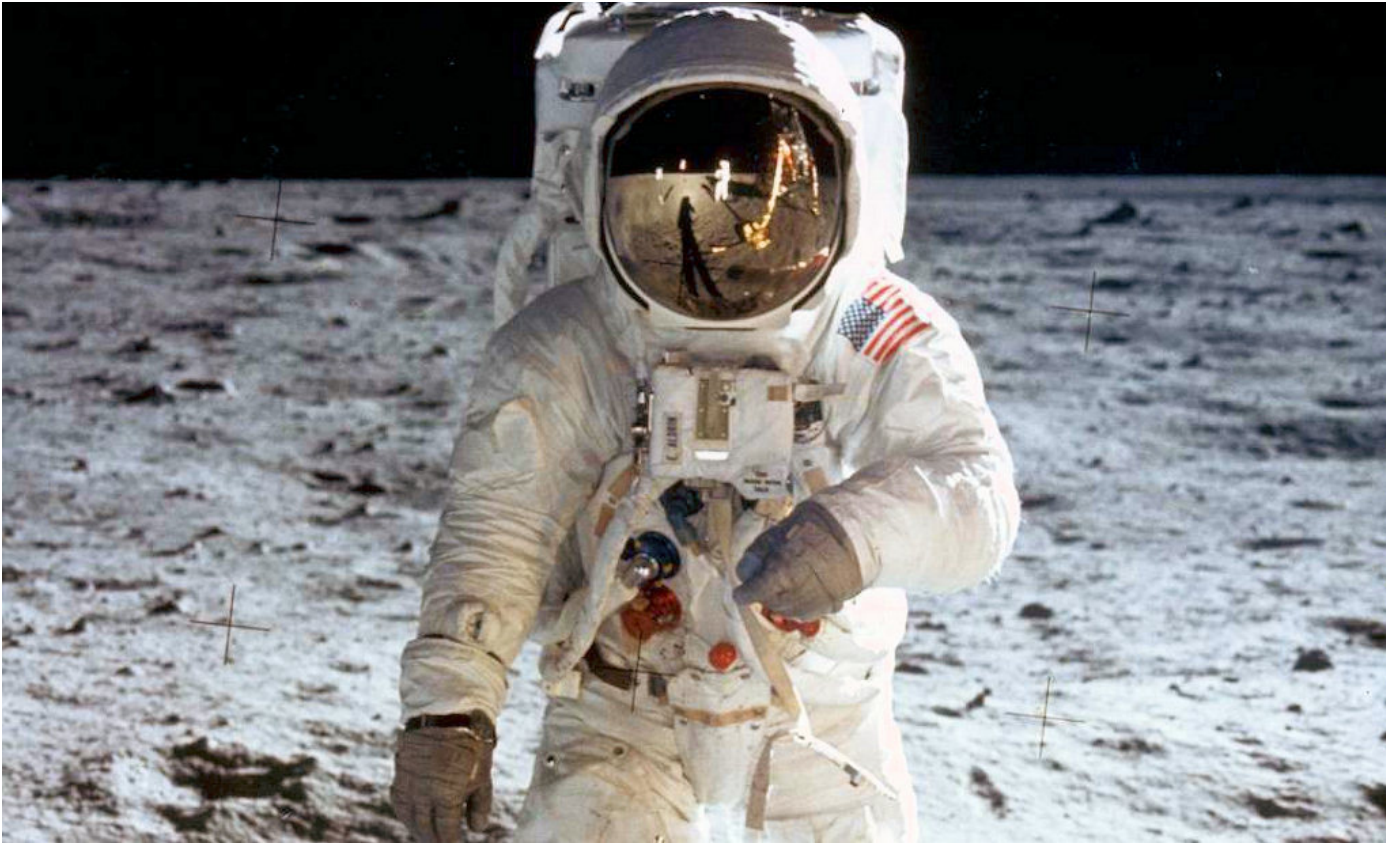

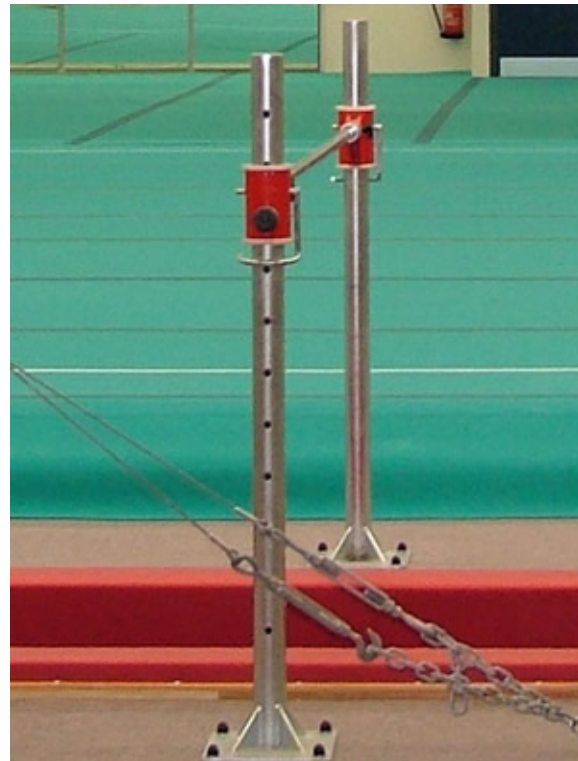

Achievements 2008-2010

- Given out £ 53,015 in grants over 3 years
- 19 individuals (increase of 6 new in 2010) have had between £1,000 & £500
- 42 clubs (increase of 11 new) have had between £2,300 & £260 (excluding any individual grants)
- Every application to benefit anyone with disabilities has been met in full (£3,200)
