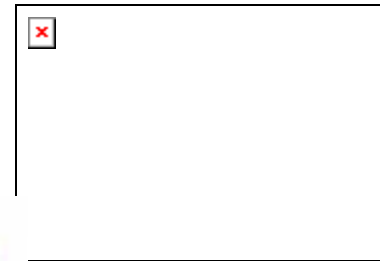

- Hub school St. Lukes (aspiring Sports College)
- Partnership Development Manager (PDM) and Assistant PDM
- 12 School Sport Co-ordinators (SSCo's) based at secondary schools
- 67 Primary Link Teachers based at primary schools
- 2 Further Education co-ordinators
- 79 schools and 2 FE Colleges in total



The 5 Hour Offer

All 5 – 16 year olds participating in at least 2 hours a week of high-quality PE and Sport at School and all 5 – 19 year olds being offered at least a further 3 hours a week of sporting participation (2008 – 2011)

The 5 hour offer/ take up...

- 2 hours PE in the curriculum
- Schools provide an extra 1 hour for all pupils on the school site

School = 3 hour take up

- 2 hours physical activity offered by the community – clubs, leisure services, on school site?

School and community 5 hour take up



5 hours of physical activity a week





Where are we now?

- 56 infant/ primary schools have 2 hours PE in the curriculum
- 4 secondary schools have 2 hours PE in the curriculum
- 43% of 5-16 year olds take part in at least 3 hours PE and school sport on the school site a week
- Schools have an average of 5 club links
